Introduction



Novell created the Certified Novell Engineer (CNE) program in 1989

The availability of CNE encouraged the adoption of Novell Netware

Sun, Microsoft, IBM and others have all created their own certification programs

What is Linux certification?



Linux certification evaluates an individual's ability to use Linux

Linux certification is usually received as the result of passing an exam

What does Linux certification offer to an individual?



Increased salary and job opportunities

Allows a person to broaden their marketable skills

What does Linux certification offer to a company?



A pool of people that meet certain minimum requirements

Offering Linux certified individuals may allow a company to charge a higher billing rate

May be used to help measure effectiveness of training programs

Is it available in my area?

Is the exam tied to a specific distribution?

Are there any continuing requirements?

Verification of certification?

Am I ready for this?

How much does it cost?

Initial Requirements : Possess LPIC Level 1

Certificate, Pass two exams

Perks : To be determined

Initial Requirements : Possess LPIC Level 2

Certificate, Pass two exams

Continuing Requirements : None

Cost : \$100 per exam

Perks : To be determined

Summary : LPIC Level 3 is currently the highest level of LPI certification. LPI will likely emerge as one of the more popular certification programs.

Initial Requirements : Hands-on lab exam, regular exam

Continuing Requirements : Must recertify for new versions of Red Hat

Cost : \$749

Perks : Certificate

Summary : RHCE is offered by one of the premiere Linux Vendors. The hands-on lab exam increases the validity of the program. Offered in a limited number of locations.

Initial Requirements : RHCE certified, training class,
pass 1 exam.

Continuing Requirements : Must recertify for new
versions of Red Hat

Cost : \$2498

Perks : Certificate

Summary : Required to be able to proctor RHCE
exams. Not really useful except for that purpose.

Sair



Sair was established in 1992. In 1999 Sair began offering Linux Certifications.

Initial Requirements : Pass either the Install & Configuration (I&C1) or System Administrators (SA1) Exam.

Continuing Requirements : None

Cost : \$99

Perks : Certificate, access to on-line forums

Summary : LCP entry level exam for Sair Linux certification. Sair is likely to emerge as one of the more popular certification programs.

Sair Linux Certified Administrator (LCA)



Initial Requirements : Pass 4 exams, 3 if already an LCP

Continuing Requirements : None

Cost : \$99 per exam

Perks : Certificate, access to on-line forums, inclusion in on-line resource database

Summary : LCA is the second level of Sair Linux certification. Sair is likely to emerge as one of the more popular certification programs.

Sair Linux/GNU Certified Engineer (LCE)



Initial Requirements : Hold LCA, Pass 4 exams


Continuing Requirements : None

Cost : \$99 per exam

Perks : Certificate, access to on-line forums, inclusion
in on-line resource database

certification. Sair is likely to emerge as one of the
more popular certification programs.

Sair Linux/GNU Certified Trainer



Initial Requirements : Take training class, must be certified in topic to teach

Continuing Requirements : None

Cost : \$1000 training class

Perks : Certificate, access to on-line forums, inclusion in on-line resource database

Summary : Required to be able to offer official training for Sair Linux/GNU certification preparation classes.
